ROLE OF PRESIDENT & VICE PRESIDENT
BY-LAW 17

17. PRESIDENT AND VICE PRESIDENT

17.1. The President shall:

- 17.1.1. preside at all meetings of the Company
- 17.1.2. in cooperation with other members of the Board and Executive Director supervise the affairs of the Company and implement any decision of the Company in Regional Council Meetings
- 17.1.3. commence all meetings with the assistance of the Secretary and Executive Director
- 17.1.4. share responsibility with the Executive Director for the release of all official information concerning the Company
- 17.1.5. perform such other duties as pertain to the duties of the office of President or as may be directed by resolution of the Board, such duties not to be inconsistent with the Articles or the By-Laws
- 17.1.6. provide effective leadership for the Company by ensuring the democratic process of decision making and implementing the vision of the Company in line with that of DPI
- 17.1.7. ensure representation at meetings of CARICOM, the OECS, the OAS, the United Nations and other regional or international organizations

- 17.2. The Vice President shall assist the President in his duties and act in the office of President in the absence of the President.
