ROLE OF EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR
BY-LAW 24

24. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

- 24.1. The Executive Director shall attend all meetings of the Company except where he is specifically requested by the Board not to so attend.

- 24.2. The Executive Director shall carry out all functions of his office as determined by contract with the Board and shall have primary responsibility for:
 - 24.2.1. in conjunction with the President, promote the public image of the Company and raise the public portfolio of the Company particularly with reference to liaising with the media for suitable coverage for the Company
 - 24.2.2. sourcing and receiving all monies paid into the Company and immediately after receipt, deposit all funds in the bank or banks of deposit prescribed by the Company except such amounts as the Board may authorise to be held as petty cash
 - 24.2.3. vetting and recommending staff positions at the Office of the Company
