TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP
BY-LAWS 7

1. TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP

7.1 Membership in the Company shall cease:

7.1.1 if the member in writing indicates to the Office of the Company his desire to resign from the Company. In such case, the Office shall inform the Board of Directors, Regional Council and DPI Headquarters, and remove the name of the member from the list of members and such membership shall cease from the effective date of receipt of the letter of resignation.

7.1.2 if a resolution is passed by the Company declaring that it is undesirable in the interest of the Company that such a member should continue as a member of the Company, provided that such resolution is assented to by a two thirds (2/3) majority of the members present and voting at any Regional Council Meeting of the Company.

7.2 On termination of membership in accordance with any of the provisions of Article 7.1. a member shall forfeit all claims to the return of money paid to the Company by way of annual subscriptions or otherwise, and shall cease to be a Member of the Company, subject nevertheless to obligations, if any, he may have incurred prior to his ceasing to be a member in accordance with the Articles of Incorporation and By-Laws.
